For your independent reading project you will be creating and presenting a poster based on your novel. Below are the instructions you will need to follow to complete this task. Neatness and creativity will be included in the overall grade. **Make sure you use ink** so that everyone will be able to see and read what you have written to share. You will need to get the HALF sheet of poster board from your teacher.

In this rectangle:

CLIMAX:

In this rectangle:

One picture (drawn, printed off computer, or cut out of magazine) representing the actions during the climax of the story. Explain the climax in **two or three complete sentences.**

FALLING ACTION:

In this rectangle:

One picture (drawn, printed off computer, or cut out of magazine) representing a significant event that happens in the Falling Action.

Explain its significance to the story in two or three complete sentences.

SETTING:

In this rectangle:

One picture (drawn, printed off computer, or cut out of magazine) representing a significant setting in the story.

Describe this setting in **two or three complete sentences**.

CHARACTER COLLAGE:

In this rectangle:

Choose one or two main characters and create a collage with words or pictures that describe them. Be prepared to explain why you chose the words and pictures you did.

The pictures and words should completely cover this rectangle
